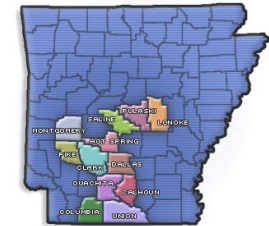

About VITA



VITA (Volunteer Income Tax Assistance Program) is free tax preparation and electronic filing by certified, trained volunteers. CADC files federal and state returns AT NO COST.

Save Money

The program promotes savings and asset development, encouraging households to avoid predatory practices such as rapid advance loans (RALs), more commonly known as rapid refunds. You've worked hard to make your money, now be wise and save it by using a free tax service!

Electronic Filing

When using VITA tax sites, you can expect to receive your federal refund within 10 days and state refunds within 5 days, if using direct deposit.

- Debit cards. If you don't have a checking or savings account, put your refund on a debit card to enjoy faster service.

What is EITC



CADC's VITA program ensures that individuals and families receive all tax benefits for which they are eligible, most importantly the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC), which has been recognized as the single most powerful tool to lift children out of poverty.

The EITC is a refundable tax credit for low- and moderate-income working taxpayers. Depending on income and number of household members, the EITC can increase a family's annual income by as much as 50%. To qualify for EITC:

2015 Tax Year—Earned Income & Adjusted Gross Income Must be Less than:

- \$47,955 (\$53,505 married filing jointly) with three or more qualifying children
- \$44,648 (\$50,198 married filing jointly) with two qualifying children
- \$39,296 (\$44,846 married filing jointly) with one qualifying child
- \$14,880 (\$20,430 married filing jointly) with no qualifying children

The maximum EITC for 2015 Tax Filing Year:

- \$6,269 with 3 or more qualifying children
- \$5,572 with 2 qualifying children
- \$3,373 with 1 qualifying child
- \$506 with 0 qualifying children

What to Bring



- Proof of identification
- Social Security Cards for you, your spouse and dependents
- Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) assignment letter for you, your spouse and dependents
- Proof of foreign status, if applying for an ITIN
- Form W-2, W-2G, 1099-R, from all employers
- Interest and dividend statements from banks (Forms 1099)
- Forms 1095A or Health Insurance Statements
- A copy of last year's federal and state returns if available
- Proof of bank account routing numbers and account numbers for Direct Deposit, such as a blank check
- Total paid for daycare provider and the daycare provider's tax id number
- To file taxes electronically on a married-filing-joint tax return, both spouses must be present to sign the required forms.
